

# Personal Protective Equipment



**WEAR YOUR  
SAFETY GLASSES**

**Eye protection** – Safety glasses provide protection from protruding or flying objects. Eye protection must be worn when grinding, welding or drilling. You must wear safety goggles or a face shield if it is identified in the operating procedures or SDS.



**Hand protection**  
- Gloves prevent cuts from sharp tools or when handling rough objects. Gloves also protect from heat and chemicals



**Hearing protection** – Earplugs or earmuffs must be worn when sign posted or if hearing damage could occur.

**Foot protection** – Protective footwear can prevent objects from injuring the foot. Protective footwear includes steel cap boots and closed in footwear.

**Respirators** – Respirators protect your mouth, nose and lungs from airborne hazards. Respirators are often used when working with chemicals. You must wear a respirator if it is identified in the SDS.



# PPE– Q & A

## **Who is responsible for providing Personal Protective Equipment?**

*Your Supervisor. Roper Gulf will provide the required PPE for you to perform your tasks safely. You must look after your PPE, and may have to return it at the end of the work day.*

## **Will PPE stop you from getting injured?**

*PPE is the last line of defence. It should not be relied on as the primary means of injury prevention until options higher up the hierarchy of controls have been exhausted. PPE may be used in conjunction with other controls (e.g. substitution, engineering, isolation) where the risk of injuries is high.*

## **Do you have to wear PPE?**

*Yes - the PPE is to protect you from getting hurt. Work Health & Safety Law says you must wear PPE provided by your employer.*

## **When do you have to wear safety glasses?**

*Eye protection must be worn when grinding, welding or drilling. You must wear safety goggles or a face shield if it is identified in the operating procedures or Chemical Safety Data Sheet*

## **Does PPE use require any training?**

*Employees who are required to use PPE will be shown how to use it. Training will be provided for specialised PPE such as harnesses. As a minimum employees will be told when the PPE is necessary, PPE donning and doffing, limitations, inspection, and maintenance of PPE.*

## **What do you do if you notice you have damaged or broken PPE?**

- Pause the task until you have the required PPE in good condition
- Notify your supervisor
- Repair or discard the damaged PPE
- Complete the task with appropriate undamaged PPE
