

STAKEHOLDER INFORMATION FOR NGUKURR ROAD WORKS 2016-17

BACKGROUND

Roper Gulf Regional Council has appointed Arnhem Frontier Construction and Civil to undertake more than \$700,000 worth of works to improve local area traffic management and local roads in Ngukurr during the 2016-17 financial year. This stakeholder information provides details on the scope of the works, as well as what traffic management arrangements will be required for the duration of the project.

SCOPE OF WORKS

The works comprise three individual components, being:

1. MUNDULOOLOO STREET - remove existing road seal and prepare for new seal; drainage - open drains, floodway and renovate mattress; reseal; seal driveways; line marking; installation of signage.
2. BOTTOM ROAD - remove existing road seal and prepare for new seal; reseal; line marking; installation of signage.
3. WOMBAT CROSSINGS - installation of five “wombat crossings” to slow traffic flow and improve pedestrian crossing safety in high-use traffic zones, as depicted by ● on the adjacent map.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Disruption to normal traffic flows will occur while works are being undertaken. Road closures will occur and detours will be in place. Stakeholders will be informed of traffic management arrangements as soon as they become available.
