Update on COVID-19 for the Roper Gulf Region 30/06/2021

The Chief Minister has today announced a 72 hour lock-down for Alice Springs.

As yet there are no further updates for the Roper Gulf and Katherine Regions, however, in line with the Northern Territory Government's recommendations, all unnecessary travel should be avoided.
