COVID-19 Update for Roper Gulf Region 20/08/2021

The Northern Territory Government has announced that the lockdown in the Katherine region has been lifted as of 12:00pm today, Friday 20 August 2021, with no new cases being recorded in the last 24 hours.

Some restrictions will remain in place until 12:00pm on Thursday 26 August 2021 in the Katherine region and Greater Darwin area to continue to reduce the risk of COVID-19.

Travel will be permitted across the Territory but restrictions continue to apply and follow you, if you travel outside of the former Katherine or Greater Darwin lockdown areas.
