COVID-19 Update for Roper Gulf Region 05/11/2021

The Northern Territory Government has announced that Katherine has been put into a COVID-19 lockdown for 72 Hours (3 days) from 12:01am on Friday 05 November until 12:01am Monday 08 November 2021, due to recording a positive case.

All Katherine-based Council staff members have been asked to work from home today unless they are essential staff **and unable to perform their duties at home**.

The Support Centre in Katherine will be closed today.

All non-Katherine based staff are to continue operating as usual and Council services and programs will continue to run across the Roper Gulf region where possible.

Please avoid non-essential travel within the Roper Gulf region until further information is available on the positive case.
