**RECOMMENDATION**

That the Mataranka Local Authority receives and notes this report.

**BACKGROUND**

At the Mataranka Local Authority Meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> of February 2023, a request was lodged requesting an update on the lifespan of the current waste facility to be provided;

- Council has identified an area of 12284 cubic meters available to be used for the disposal of solid waste
- Current waste collection from commercial and domestic users is in the vicinity of 258 cubic meters a month. (134 cubic meters domestic- 558 Bins a Month and 124 cubic meters commercial – 41 trailers a month)
- Compaction rates is about 30% which reduces monthly volumes to 181 cubic meters
- On current volumes lifespan is  $12284/181 = 67$  Months (5.6 years)

**ISSUES**

- Current projected lifespan could be affected by users not segregating waste streams
